FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

For artists donating to the auction



I'm not a member of MAWA. Can I still donate?

Yes, MAWA gratefully welcomes donations.



What kind of work do you accept?

Artists are asked to donate one or more pieces of art. All proceeds go towards Mentoring Artists for Women's Art. We gratefully accept work in a range of media including drawing, painting, photography, collage, textile-based soft sculpture and more.



Is MAWA only allowing women to participate?

No! We WELCOME ALL ARTISTS' donations as part of "Over the Top" by donating artwork and joining in the festivities! We regret however, that we cannot accept children's artwork, but kids are more than welcome to munch on cupcakes on the day of the auction (mmm... sweet sugary goodness!!!).



Where and when can I drop off my artwork?

MAWA is located at 611 Main St.

We accept submissions beginning Tuesday March 9 to Wednesday March 17th between 10 am and 4 pm.

LAST DAY EXTENDED HOURS: Wednesday March 17th, 10 am - 8 pm.

PLEASE NOTE: MAWA is closed on Sundays, Mondays and most Saturdays. Please heed last day's deadline or we may not be able to include your work in the auction. If none of these times work for you, contact MAWA's office at 949-9490.



Do I have to submit anything with my work?

Please fill out a MAWA contract and submit it with your artwork. This allows us to keep track of your work, hang/install according to your instructions and title accordingly. You can fill out a contract at MAWA when you drop off your submission or you can download a contract online from the PDF linked to our website www.mawa.ca.



WILL I RECEIVE A TAX RECEIPT?

Only those artists whose works are sold will receive a charitable tax receipt. Charitable tax receipts will be issued for the amount the work sells for on March 21.



WHAT IF MY WORK IS NOT SOLD AT AUCTION?

If work is unsold at "Over the Top" the artist will be contacted by MAWA to arrange for pick up. For out of town members, MAWA will arrange shipping.



I'M AN OUT-OF-TOWN ARTIST. HOW CAN I CONTRIBUTE?

Work must be sent at the artist's own expense. If it is not sold, MAWA will call you to discuss pick up or shipping.

HOW MANY ARTWORKS ARE INCLUDED IN THE SILENT AUCTION?

In past events we have auctioned over 100 artworks. MAWA has received artworks donated by local and national artists working in all media.



WHAT IS THE MINIMUM BID FOR ARTWORK?

Bidding starts at \$50.00.



WHERE CAN I BUY TICKETS?

Tickets are \$10 each and can be purchased in advance at MAWA, 611 Main Street, during our regular office hours: Tuesday to Friday 10am - 4pm. You must pay for your ticket(s) with cash or cheque only. You can also purchase advance tickets from a MAWA board member. Tickets provide entry to the MAWA "Over the Top" fundraiser as well as hot coffee and plenty of

cupcakes. You must have a ticket to bid on artworks.

Donating artists receive a free entry ticket which has no cash value.



CAN I PREVIEW THE WORKS?

Yes. You can preview the works at MAWA the day before the auction on Saturday March 20, from 10 am- 4 pm.



WHAT ARE THE CLOSING TIMES FOR THE AUCTION?

Artworks are auctioned in colour-coded lots. Not all lots close at once. Bid early, and bid often! Lots close at 3:45pm / 4:05pm / 4:25pm / 4:45pm and 4:55pm.



WHAT ELSE CAN I PURCHASE AT THE AUCTION?

We'll have a raffle with items and gift certificates donated by generous local businesses and friends. We'll also have plenty of MAWA merchandise on sale: our sassy MAWA totes, new "I Love MAWA" tee-shirts, MAWA buttons and more!

MAWA will have a Visa/Debit machine on the day of the event.
